

## Tues., March 2 – CRYSTAL LAKE / WAIKIKI

This morning your limousine will transfer you to Chicago's O'Hare International Airport for our transpacific flight traveling en route to Honolulu, Hawaii, known as "The Gathering Place", Oahu is alive with activity. We are greeted by the warm trade winds and a traditional Hawaiian "lei" and "aloha"! A short drive remains to our hotel in the heart of Waikiki.

## Wed., March 3 – WAIKIKI

This morning, we will relive a "moment in history" when we visit Pearl Harbor's Arizona Memorial and Visitors Center. We'll stop at the Visitors Center to watch a short film depicting the events that unfolded on December 7, 1941. Then we'll board a navy launch for the short journey to the U.S.S. Arizona where we'll disembark for an up close, unforgettable experience. Next, we'll travel across the Ford Island Bridge to tour the celebrated USS Missouri Battleship where on September 2, 1945 General MacArthur accepted the Japanese surrender that ended World War II. Next we visit the beauty and solemnity of Punchbowl Cemetery, officially known as the National Memorial Cemetery of the Pacific, located in an extinct volcano. Followed by Honolulu's most famous landmarks and buildings, including Iolani Palace – the only royal palace in the United States – and the King Kamehameha statue. This evening we enjoy a welcome dinner overlooking Waikiki Beach. (B,D)

## Thurs., March 4 – WAIKIKI

Today is at leisure to explore Honolulu. Explore Kalakaua Avenue with its fabulous shops and great restaurants. Find a delightful spot on iconic Waikiki Beach to relax and enjoy the activity on the beach. An **optional** Circle Oahu Tour will be offered, that will explore the wonders of this fabulous Island. From the pineapple fields of the Dole Pineapple Plantation to the beaches of the famous North Shore to the historic scenic Nu'uuanu Pali Lookout. (B)

## Fri., March 5 - HONOLULU / HILO / KONA

This morning we will depart the Island of Oahu on the short flight to Hilo, located on the east coast of the "Big Island" of Hawaii. On arrival in Hilo, we visit the Mauna Loa Macadamia Nut Farm. We continue to the impressive lava flows at Volcano National Park. We begin with an included lunch before we see the wide array of unique volcanic formations, forests of giant tree ferns and steaming craters. Next, we'll visit Punaluu Beach, famous for its black sand and sea turtles. Enjoy a visit to



the Punaluu Bake Shop, famous for their marmalades. This afternoon we arrive in the town of Kailua-Kona, and our resort for the next two nights. (B,L)

## Sat., March 6 - KONA

Today is free in Kona, perhaps to enjoy a visit to the fishing village of Kailua and the summer palace of Hawaiian royalty down the street, or simply relax with an afternoon aboard one of the glass bottom boats. For the more adventurous, you may prefer an afternoon of snorkeling or to try your luck at deep sea fishing for blue marlin, the Kona Coast is famous for it! This evening, we enjoy dinner at a local Kona restaurant. (B,D)

## Sun., March 7 - KONA / MAUI

This morning, we bid farewell to Kona and the Big Island, as we board our short flight to the Island of Maui, known as the Valley Isle. On arrival we visit the Maui Tropical Plantation where we take the Tropical Express tour giving us an overview of Hawaii's famous fruits and plants. Next, we visit the Maui Ocean Center where we will have an understanding, wonder and respect for Hawaii's marine life. We arrive at our hotel on the shores of beautiful Kānāpali Beach. The remainder of the day is at leisure, perhaps a stroll to Whaler's Village an oceanfront dining and shopping venue. (B)

## Mon., March 8 - MAUI

Today is at leisure to relax on beautiful Kānāpali Beach. An **optional** whale watching excursion will be available. During Maui's whale season (Dec 15th-Apr15th), a whale watch cruise is a must-do!

We will depart from Ka'anapali Beach on a 2-hour Whale Watch cruise! Our Captain and Crew will welcome you aboard as we set sail, serving you with either a hot cinnamon roll with fresh fruit or a deli slider with fruit and a cookie. And with a cold beverage in hand, get ready for the sheer thrill of seeing Maui's humpback whales as they spout and breach their way along the coastline!

This evening listen for the conch shell that signals the beginning of the traditional Hawaiian Luau as we savor one of the most beautiful sunsets in the Pacific. We will be amazed with the display of authentic Polynesian activities, cuisine, and performances. (B,D)

### **Tues., March 9 - MAUI / EN ROUTE**

On our final day in Maui, the rich cultural history and natural beauty come alive on our adventure to the Iao Valley State Park, which served as a burial ground for Hawaiian royalty, we see where King Kamehameha defeated Maui's army to unite the Hawaiian Islands. The lush park is also home to the famous Iao Needle, a heavily eroded peak that rises sharply 2,500 feet above sea level to form a dramatic centerpiece in the valley. This afternoon we arrive at Maui's Kahului Airport for the beginning of our return journey to Crystal Lake. (B)

### **Wed., Mar. 10 - EN ROUTE / CRYSTAL LAKE**

Early this morning we will arrive at Chicago's O'Hare International Airport. Once you gather your luggage your limousine will whisk you home.
