Fri., Apr. 17 - HOME TOWN / PORTLAND

Depart from your home via limousine to Chicago's O'Hare International Airport, for our flight to Portland, Oregon.

Sat., Apr. 18 - CRUISING (Portland)

Situated between the waters of the Columbia and Willamette Rivers, Portland's history is forever entwined with the fortunes of these great rivers. Today, we transfer to our river cruise ship the American Jazz. (B,L,D)

Sun., April 19 - CRUISING (Astoria, OR)

We begin with a visit to Astoria, the oldest American settlement west of the Rockies. In the winter of 1805-06, the Lewis & Clark Expedition was headquartered at Fort Clatsop. In 1955, a replica of the fort was built near the original site and was eventually named a National Monument. With its steep hills and beautiful Victorian homes, Astoria has been called the "Little San Francisco of the Pacific Northwest" and has a revitalized downtown ideal for shopping and dining. **(B,L,D)**

Mon., Apr. 20 - CRUISING (Kalama, WA)

Perhaps the most impactful of all landmarks in the region is Mount St. Helens. From high on an overlook, bear witness to the awesome power of the volcano, whose eruption in 1980 scorched 230 square miles of forest land and forever changed the landscape. Expert guides will show us the pumice plain and lava dome as they explain the effect the volcano had on the lives of those in the surrounding towns. (**B,L,D**)

Tues., Apr 21 - CRUISING (The Dalles, OR)

Welcome to The Dalles, the final frontier of the iconic Oregon Trail! With the towering Mount Hood and Mount Adams as your stunning backdrop, each reaching over 11,000 feet, this stop possesses all the natural beauty the Pacific Northwest is known for. Today we visit Multnomah Falls, Plummeting 620 feet, it is second highest year-round waterfall in the nation. Admire the falls from the Visitor Center or take a short hike to Benson Bridge, one of the most photographed pieces of architecture in Oregon, to feel its misty spray and get a great photo. Multnomah Falls. (**B**,**L**,**D**)

Wed., Apr. 22 - CRUISING (Columbia River Gorge)

Get ready to seize the day and watch the Columbia River Gorge develop. Behold the majestic bluffs cloaked in greenery, while hillsides reach for the sky. The dynamic landscape is truly a wonder, catch the best views up on the sun deck. But that's just the beginning, as we get ready for a range of exhilarating activities tailored just for you. Engage in destination enrichment programs. From captivating Art Classes to mastering the latest tech with our Aptitude sessions, sizzling Cooking Demonstrations, Mixology magic, and brain-teasing Trivia– there is so much to discover on board. **(B,L,D)**

Thurs., Apr. 23 - CRUISING (Pendleton)

Today we have a look into Pendleton's infamous and entertaining past. No town has a more colorful history. Find out why Pendleton was known as the entertainment capital of Eastern Oregon as you follow your guide underground to the Shamrock Card Room, Hop Sing's (Chinese Laundry), the Empire Ice Cream Parlor, and through the tunnels beneath the sidewalls to the Empire Meat Market. Stand under prism glass and go through a secret passageway to a prohibition Card Room. Continue through the tunnels to the Duck Pin Bowling Alley where you will learn about the Triple Nickels and Doolittle Raiders who trained here. Explore the Tamastslikt Cultural Institute to learn about the storied past, contemporary culture, and bright economic future of the Cayuse, Umatilla, and Walla Walla Tribes. In the expansive Museum Store, discover the creativity of dozens of tribal artists as well as books, music, huckleberry treats, and exclusive Tamastslikt limitededition collectible Pendleton blankets. Along the way, enjoy conversations with elders, traveling exhibits, storytelling, and hands-on displays. (**B**,**L**,**D**)

Fri., April 24 - CRUISING (Hells Canyon)

Today we enjoy a boat excursion through Hells Canyon, North America's deepest river gorge. The 10-mile wide canyon was carved out from significant events occurring 15,000 years ago, including a flood from the Glacial Lake Bonneville in Utah. Once a destination for miners, explorers, and settlers, Hells Canyon is now a popular recreation area. We will explore places most boats cannot reach on the river and witness the amazing transformation in geography from high desert to alpine forests. View ancient rock formations and native pictographs while your local guide provides interesting stories about the regions history and canyon formation. Enjoy a snacks at the exclusive ranch. 


